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Storm Drain Improvements Planned

Staff members from the Watershed Engineering Division (WED) of Watershed Protection will present their plans for the Lightsey/Wilson phase of the four-part Dawson Storm Drain Improvements project intended to address flooding reported by many Dawson residents. The flooding is caused by an outdated and inadequate storm drain system that lacks the capacity to carry water during severe storms. Briefly, WED will add new curbside drains and underground pipes along **Sacramento, Wilson, Powell, South Park, Lightsey and Havana**, all of which will drain into the creek at Wilson Street.

WED does not expect construction for the Lightsey/Wilson project to begin until late 2010 or early 2011. However, WED would like to finalize the project's design by the end of February 2010 so that they can begin the permitting process and are asking for residents' feedback regarding the design. There will be a limited time for discussion at the meeting. So we encourage you to send comments and questions prior to the meeting to Kam Magor at kamtree@gmail.com, or 440-1464, so she can forward them as a whole to WED.
